

SRC Exam Revision Checklist

A practical checklist for Marine Radio SRC, VHF, DSC, and spoken procedure revision.

Core knowledge

- SRC purpose, operator responsibility, radio discipline, and licensing context.
- VHF range, antenna height, power settings, squelch, dual watch, and listening watch.
- Phonetic alphabet, numbers, call signs, MMSI, ATIS where relevant, and procedure words.

Channels and call types

- Channel 16 voice distress, urgency, safety, and initial calling.
- Channel 70 DSC alerts only.
- Routine calls, marina calls, port operations, intership calls, and working channels.

Distress, urgency, and safety

- Mayday, Mayday Relay, Pan-Pan, Securite, cancellation, and silence control basics.
- Position formats, nature of problem, assistance required, persons on board, and intentions.
- DSC alert categories and follow-up voice call structure.

Final practice

- Say full calls aloud, not just in your head.
- Run a mixed mock after topic revision.
- Fix wrong channel or wrong priority mistakes before polishing wording.
